

JOINT IANZ/NATA ENDORSEMENT TESTING LABORATORIES - REQUIREMENTS FOR USE

The Testing Laboratory Registration Council of New Zealand, operating as **International Accreditation New Zealand (IANZ)**, and the **National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA)**, Australia, have approved the use of a special endorsement to recognise the Mutual Recognition Arrangement (MRA) between the two accrediting bodies.

The use of the special endorsement is subject to the following conditions:

1. The special IANZ/NATA endorsement shall be used only on test reports endorsed by IANZ in which all tests reported have been performed in accordance with a laboratory's terms of accreditation. (The requirements for test reports endorsed by IANZ are as set out in *Procedures and Conditions for Accreditation*).
2. The special IANZ/NATA endorsement does not constitute NATA endorsement.
3. The special IANZ/NATA endorsement shall be as follows:
 - Both the IANZ Accredited Laboratory logo and the NATA logo must be shown and have equal prominence.
 - The statement must be worded as shown in the example below.
 - The two logos must be closely associated with the statement (as illustrated in the example below).
 - Wording of the statement and logos must be easily readable - see example below.
4. No other form of special endorsement shall be used.
